


Routines

Familiarity with routines, help children to feel comfortable and secure in their new surroundings as they understand what is expected and what comes next. Parents are asked to assist children with the following arrival routines each morning:

- Remove shoes and socks and store in lockers.
- Store lunch boxes and sheets in appropriate baskets.
- Place other named belongings in lockers.
- Sign attendance record and apply child's own sunscreen.
- Help your child to greet staff and join the group for group time.

When departing in the afternoon please advise staff that you are leaving and help your child to collect his / her art work and belongings and farewell staff.

It's time for our first social function!


Saturday 18th February - 4.00pm till 6.00pm - Unit 1 Playground. BYO teddy and a picnic rug.

Saying Goodbye

Separating from parents and saying goodbye can be difficult for some children especially in their first days at kindergarten, when everything is new and possibly uncertain. These hints have proven to be helpful:

- Keep goodbyes short to limit upset and stress.
- If you expect that your child will be distressed please advise staff who will provide additional assistance and support.
- Advise your child that you are going, giving him / her a kiss and cuddle and leave quickly.
- Later, if you are worried about how your child has settled please phone our centre on 33784469 for an update...most tears and upset at separation last only a few minutes, if that!

Remember: A quick goodbye is better for children than a long drawn out one, which only causes stress and upset. We are here to help you if your child has difficulty separating from you. Please talk to us.



Play Dough Recipe

Play Dough is fun for all ages and it is also a fun activity to have at a home. You can buy Play Dough already made, but it is even more fun to let the kids create their own. We would like to share with you a great Play Dough Recipe that can be easily created with simple ingredients you may all ready have in your home.

Set up your table with fun tools such as Cookie Cutters, Plastic Utensils, Toothpicks and any other items that the kids can use to shape and make designs in their Dough. Also consider using a disposable tablecloth or messy mat on the table and/or on the floor (especially if you are doing this activity where there is carpet).

Other Tips:

Make sure kids have washed their hands prior to playing. If Play Dough becomes too dry you can always add in a drop of water. If Play Dough becomes too sticky add in some flour. Use food colouring to colour your doughs different colours. Store Play Dough in either an air-tight container or a ziploc baggie.

Put on some music and let the kids have lots of free play as they create their little dough masterpieces. You can even create different categories like Most Creative, Funniest, Best Play Dough Pet etc...

Coloured Play Dough Recipe

- 1 Cup Flour
- 1 Tbsp Vegetable Oil 1 Cup Water 1/2 Cup Salt 2 Tsp Cream of Tarter Natural Food Colouring
